


Tuesday March 25th at Creekside Community Common House

"Watermelon snow" darken the snow surface, thereby accelerating snow melt.

At the same time, snow algal blooms are endangered by loss of summer snowfields.

How they colonize the snow surface each spring remains a mystery.

Dr. Casey Engstrom will introduce you to these charismatic microflora and share stories of searching for them in the mountains of BC.
